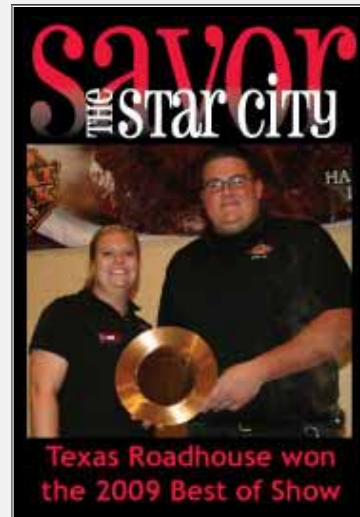
Lincoln Chamber Continues to Grow
